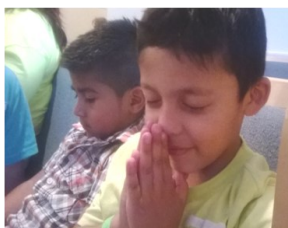

KBC AT CAMP GRACE BY PAT HAMMOND

Camp Grace is an extraordinary Christian Summer Camp for children ages 7 to 17. They invited the Kid's Bible Club to come to their weeklong camps in Roberta, Georgia. We were blessed to take a total of 98 children on three different weeks. When the first 44 kids, ages 7-12, went down to stay, they came back, so excited and telling about their awesome time. Camp Grace, gave us an extra week for another 34 children ages 7-12. Each time they had places to stay and things to do that children dream about: swimming, horseback riding, zip lining, canoeing, fishing, archery, basketball, outdoor games, skits, elective classes on about everything you could think of and best of all they heard the Gospel. Camp counselors were young adults, mature in their Christian faith, who attended intensive training. They loved on and cared for our kids, like they had known and loved them forever! Our third and final week was for our teenagers. Some of those who grew up attending KBC and now serve as bus helpers and teacher aides to our children each week also attended. A few of them had been counselor's assistants at Camp Grace at an earlier week of camp, but this time they were able to do the fun things the campers were doing, not just help and watch. They really had a wonderful time. A local charity provided KBC with the funds to obtain an older air conditioned bus so we could take the camp trips more comfortably to South Georgia. We were fortunate to have many of our faithful supporters sponsor the kids we took. Thank you so much for making this happen! Several kids made decisions to follow Christ and were later baptized at KBC. Each trip, we had 2 or more of our KBC volunteer staff stay



in case our kids needed one of us. During this time, the camp held a separate program for our staff where they led us in Bible study, activities and ministry workshops ministering to KBC leadership. Camp Grace provided a beautiful apartment there for us to live in for the week and our camp facilitator helped make our stay at Camp Grace wonderful too. God has truly blessed Kid's Bible Club in 2014 and used many of His people to give, pray and serve. It has been our best year yet! Thank you so much for being a part of God's Blessings for His Children!
